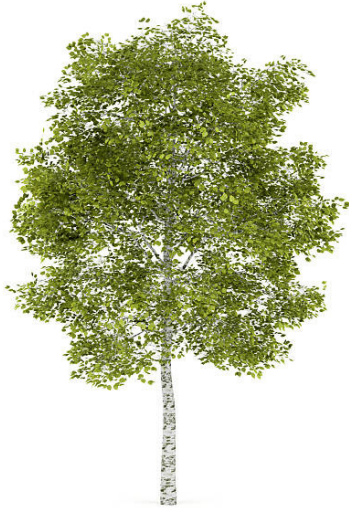

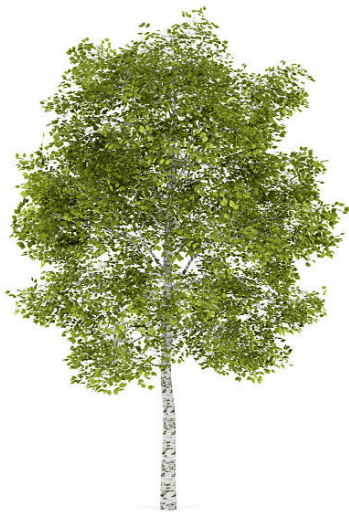

# DO YOU KNOW?



- Spruce cones grow down, while fir cones grow up.
- Fir needles have two white stripes on the underside.
- Ginkgo biloba is the oldest surviving tree species on the planet. The species is more than 200 million years old.
- Sgerma spruce, which grows on Ribniško Pohorje (Slovenia), is the tallest tree in Central Europe. It is 61.8 meters high and about 300 years old.
- Naje linden tree, which grows in Carinthia (Slovenia), is the thickest tree in the country. Its perimeter measures 13.5 meters. It is about 750 years old.
- The oldest Slovenian tree is larch in the Upper Sava Valley, which is between 800 and 1000 years old.
